



# CONSTITUTION OF QUEEN'S FIRST AID CAMPUS RESPONSE TEAM

## ARTICLE I: Name

The official name of this club will be "Queen's First Aid Campus Response Team". The common name will be "Queen's First Aid". The club will also be known as "St. John Ambulance Division 970".

## ARTICLE II: Affiliation

The club is the duly established medical first response division 970 of The Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem under the Priory Council of Ontario, Loyalist Branch, and St. John Ambulance.

## ARTICLE III: Mission
